Holy Week and Easter Services

We begin Holy Week with **Palm Sunday** services at 8 and 10:30 am on **March 28**. At the later service we will gather in the Garden for the traditional Procession of the Palms.

Throughout Holy Week community services will be offered at noon, Monday through Thursday, at a local church. This usually includes a short service followed by a simple meal.

The **Maundy Thursday** service will be on **April 1** at 6 pm, including Footwashing and Holy Eucharist.


Good Friday features two services: Stations of the Cross at noon and the Good Friday liturgy at 6 pm.

The Great Vigil of **Easter** will be celebrated at 6 am on April 4 with the Easter Sunday Festival Eucharist offered at 10:30 am.
